POSITION PURPOSE:

- Serve as lifeguard at waterfront
- Enforce established waterfront guidelines
- Conduct swim tests
- Participate in all canoe/boat excursions
- Supervise daily clean-up of waterfront
- Supervise health and safety at waterfront and maintains a well-equipped first aid kit
- Teaches classes in swimming and canoeing according to interest and as time permits
- Support other camp operations when not at waterfront
- Other duties as needed and assigned

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be at least 18 years of age or a high school graduate with diploma or GED
- Preferred: One year of college or other training after high school.
- A personal commitment to Christ
- Possess management and leadership qualities
- Must work well with others, of all ages and the desire and ability to work kids.
- Desire to obtain small group camping leadership and recreation leadership skills
- Maturity in judgment, ability to teach and supervise and maintain discipline.
- Skills and talents in the area which one is designated to instruct
- Good health and stamina
- Current Red Cross Water Safety Instructor certificate preferred
- Experience in lifeguarding and waterfront operations
- Clarity in explaining and enforcing waterfront rules
- Experience with canoes and boating safety

*Required: Current Lifeguard and First Aid/CPR Certification; Current Water Safety Instructor Certificate preferred.

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EVALUATION: Evaluation of work shall be reviewed at least once during the summer camping season by the Program Director. The Employee will complete and return summer evaluation forms to the Program Director prior to the release of the final paycheck for the season.
